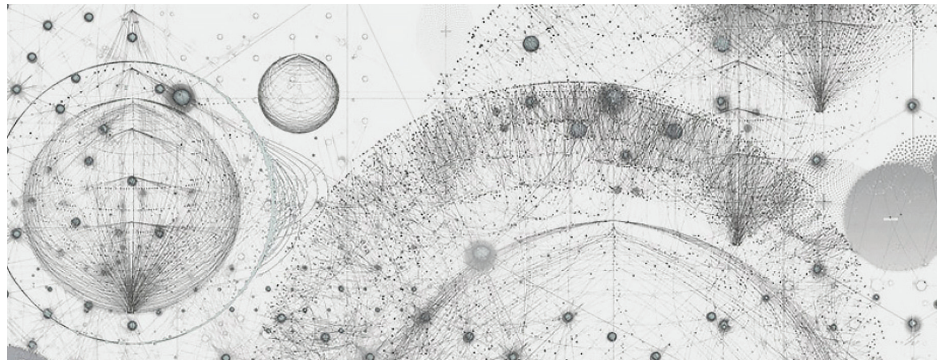
This chart tallies the number of Laureates published per decade since the prize was first awarded.

BREAKTHROUGH PRIZE LAUREATES PUBLISHED IN **Science**

Science has published articles by Breakthrough Prize Winners since the award's inception.

Award categories include Life Sciences, Fundamental Physics, and Mathematics. Founded by a team of innovators in technology, the annual prize celebrates the best examples of scientific work and inspires scientific ambition.

With the understanding that knowledge is humanity's greatest asset, the Breakthrough Prizes were created to honor those who ask the truly big questions across the scope of fundamental science. Founded by Sergey Brin and Anne Wojcicki, Mark Zuckerberg and Priscilla Chan, Yuri and Julia Milner, and Jack Ma and Cathy Zhang, laureates receive \$3 million.

A committee comprising previous prize laureates oversees the online, open nomination and selection process. Winners attend an award ceremony designed to share their achievements through lectures and discussions, inspiring the next generation of scientists. Laureates can go on to earn additional prizes for new discoveries.
